Did You Know

That there was a 10-day general strike in May 1926? The newborn Queen (as she later was) would not have noticed but the strike affected transport as well as heavy industry, so the people of Westbury would have – the Great Western Railway was closed.

That in 1968/9 emergency repairs were needed at All Saints', Westbury? An underground culvert broke and the foundations of the church became saturated, causing the masonry to crack and the tower to lean. Ordinary services could be held in halls during the repairs, but baptisms, funerals and marriages were held at Holy Saviour, Westbury Leigh.

That the population of the Westbury Community Area in 2011 was estimated as 19,650? The area is Westbury and surrounding villages (73 sq km). Of the 20 community areas in Wiltshire, Westbury is no 13 (Chippenham is no 1 at 45,000 and Mere no 20 at 5,000). The population growth 2001 – 11 was 24% (the 2nd highest in Wiltshire) and the population density has gone up from 217 to 269 per sq km (the 7th highest in Wiltshire). And there are more housing developments planned...
