Did You Know

That a history of Baptist chapels in West Wiltshire was published in 1890? It includes Westbury Leigh, which was unusual in having two chapels (Westbury Leigh and Penknapp). The history was revised in 2005, giving a fascinating comparison. *20 Golden Candlesticks! and 20 Golden Candlesticks Revisited* are both available in the Local Studies section at Westbury Library. Of course, the Westbury Leigh chapel has recently been sold (again) as a residence.

That 149 Westbury Leigh was built in 1926 as the manse for Penknapp Providence Baptist Church? Improvements, including electric lighting, were made in 1937.

That local products can be found on Ebay? Recently there was a pair of new leather gloves, probably from the 1950s, in their original packaging from Boulton Bros. The Boulton Bros glove factory was at the bottom of School Lane. The building is still there, now converted into the Caspian Gardens flats. As a nice touch, the factory name has been repainted on the east gable end.
