That Westbury was the name of a parliamentary constituency for more than 550 years? It was the name from 1449 to 2010. The constituency – essentially the same in area - is now called South West Wiltshire.

That the founder of *The Economist* weekly newspaper was MP for Westbury? James Wilson founded the newspaper in 1843 to campaign for free trade. He was Westbury's MP 1847 – 57.

A team of 55 (mostly part time) staff and 133 volunteers helped us provide advice on benefits, debt, housing, employment and other issues across Wiltshire.
